

ABOUT OUR TRIP



This year Family of Christ is partnering with Luther Crest This is a Lutheran-based organization that offers mission trips around the country.

Duluth has the largest metropolitan area on Lake Superior with a MSA population of 279,771, the second largest in Minnesota.

Situated on the north shore of Lake Superior, Duluth is accessible to oceangoing vessels from the Atlantic Ocean 2,300 miles away via the Great Lakes Waterway & the Saint Lawrence Seaway.

Duluth forms part of the Great Lakes' largest port, transporting coal, iron ore (taconite), & grain.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How will we get there?

Personal vehicles and bus.

Where will we stay while serving?

We will stay with ELCA congregations in Duluth. At most of our sites this means that you will be sleeping on the floor, so be sure to bring an air mattress!

Do we work with other youth groups? Will we be split up?

We believe that one of the greatest joys in serving is to work with others. Youth from FoC will be placed in a work crew with at least one leader from your group. The work crew may also contain youth and leaders from other congregations, giving you the opportunity to meet new friends while you serve!

What does a typical day look like?

A typical day begins breakfast and devotions, followed by serving at a worksite. The late afternoon and early evening have time scheduled for showers, free time, dinner and a variety of evening events. The day concludes with worship, a time for groups to check-in, and a little more free time before lights out. Sleep fast after a full, fun, and meaningful day!

Do we get to do anything fun?

Yes! Besides the awesomely fun days of service, we have free time and scheduled events in the afternoon and evening. These events take advantage of some of the cultural attractions in the community of Duluth as well as providing opportunity to be social and get to know and spend time with old and new friends alike.

What do we eat?

All meals are provided and coordinated through Luthercrest.


